



WELSH NORTHERN COUNTIES LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION

Rules for WNCLGA Championship

1. Each Lady member must be a full member of her Club, County Association and the Welsh Northern Counties Golf Association.
2. The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and such Local Rules and Conditions of Competition shall be approved by the WNCGA Committee. To be eligible to enter every player must have played 5 qualifying rounds of golf in the presiding 12 months at time of entry
3. Entries and Fees must reach the WNCGA by the required date.
4. All players must be of Amateur Status as defined by the Rules of Amateur Status
5. Entrants must be able to provide proof of handicap if requested by the WNCGA committee, failure to do so may result in disqualification.
6. Entry will be accepted should handicap indices exceed the maximum handicap for the Stableford Competition but not the stroke play at close of entry; but the players will have to play off the maximum handicap on the day of the competition.
7. The use of buggies in all matches will be allowed for medical reasons only and only the player eligible to use one.
8. WNCGA follows Wales Golf's Gender and Fairness Policy .
9. If, in the opinion of the WNCGA Committee, it becomes impossible to complete the Championship in accordance with the Championship's Terms of Competition because of adverse weather or other circumstances, the WNCGA Committee may vary the Terms of Competition to the extent necessary to achieve a result within the time available
10. Any photographs (eg at a prize presentation) should not be publicly displayed or published on social media unless the prior permission of the player/players

or in the case of a junior/juniors, their parents/guardians. Permission of all the players / juniors in the photographs has been obtained.

11. WNCGA collects and uses personal information provided by you as part of the entry process. This information is used to; administer the competition, including the publication of results and reporting of scores and to maintain a historical record of entrants and results. WNCGA, and any representative running an event on its behalf, will use the above information to administer the competition, and to maintain a historical record of entrants and results. Consistent with these uses, information will be shared with the tournament software provider e.g. Handicap Masters
